Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container. (1), Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1), and Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A staff member was left alone on the playground caring for eighteen, two-year-old children. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/28/2024

● **Incident Reports Were Not Completed Each Time a Child Was Injured, It Did Not Include All the Information Required in Rule, It Was Not Signed by the Parent...**
