(3), The Office Shall Require the Child Day Care Program to Immediately Post Upon Receipt, in a Prominent Place at the Program That Is Visible to Parents, a Copy Of (1), and All Paths of Egress on the Interior and Exterior of the Home, Including Corridors, Aisles and Approaches Must Be Kept Free of Obstructions, Impediments and Debr (1).
