Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Barriers Must Exist to Prevent Children From Gaining Access to Any Swimming Pool, Drainage Ditches, Wells, Ponds or Other Bodies of Open Water Located on or Adj (2) and One Caregiver May Care for a Maximum of Six Children Younger Than School Age, or Eight Children When at Least Two of the Eight Children Are School Aged. (2). None of the 4 findings were critical.
