(1), In Addition to a Smoke Detector on Each Floor, There Must Be a Smoke Detector Located Either Within Rooms Where Children Nap, or in Adjoining Rooms. In the Case (1), and Operating Carbon Monoxide Detectors Must Be Used in All Group Family Day Care Homes When Required, and Located in Areas of the Home in Accordance with Applicabl (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
