(3), All Child Care Programs Must Have at Least One Caregiver, Who Holds a Valid Certification in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and First Aid, on the Premises (1), and Evacuation Drills Must Be Conducted at Least Monthly During the Hours of Operation of the Family Day Care Home.
