Such Arrangements Shall Include (3), The Program Must Obtain a Written Statement, From the Parent of Each Infant in Care, Setting Forth the Breast Milk, Formula and Feeding Schedule Instructions For (1), and There Must Be a Cushioned Surface Under All Outside Play Equipment That Present a Fall Hazard. Surfacing May Not Include Concrete, Asphalt, Grass or Hard Compac (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
