Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Children Cannot Be Left Without Competent Direct Supervision at Any Time. Competent Supervision Includes Awareness of and Responsibility for the Ongoing Activit (2), Buildings, Systems and Equipment Must Be Kept in Good Repair and Operate as Designed. (1), and Evacuation Drills Must Be Conducted at Least Monthly During Various Hours of Operation of the School Age Child Care Program. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
