(2), The Office Shall Require the Child Day Care Program to Immediately Post Upon Receipt, in a Prominent Place at the Program That Is Visible to Parents, a Copy Of (1), and Initial Medical Statements Sent in with the Application or as a Result of a New Hire Must Be Dated Within 12 Months Preceding the Date of Application or Hiring (1).
