Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Other Than for School Age Children, Sleeping and Napping Arrangements Must Be Made in Writing Between the Parent and the Program. Such Arrangements Shall Include (2), Caregivers and Volunteers Must Ensure That Children Thoroughly Wash Their Hands or Assist Children with Thoroughly Washing Their Hands with Soap and Running Wat (2), and When Care Is Provided for Children Under the Age of Two Years, There Must Be at Least One Caregiver Present for Every Two Children Under the Age of Two Years In (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
