Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Each Employee and Volunteer Must Complete a Minimum of Thirty (30) Hours of Training Every Two Years. The Required 30 Hours of Training Every Two Years Is Subject to the Following Conditions: Fifteen of the Required Thirty (30) Hours of Training Must Be Obtained Through In-House Training (2), Disposable Gloves Must Be Discarded After Each Use. (1), and In Hiring Caregivers Subsequent to Issuance of a License, a Program: Must Ensure That a Medical Statement Has Been Submitted Before the Person Has Any Involvement with the Program (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
