Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were If More Than One Child in the Program Is Receiving Breast Milk, Infant Formula or Other Individualized Food Items, All Containers or Bottles Must Be Clearly Mar (2), All Paths of Egress on the Interior and Exterior of the Home, Including Corridors, Aisles and Approaches Must Be Kept Free of Obstructions, Impediments and Debr (2), and When Care Is Provided for Children Under the Age of Two Years, There Must Be at Least One Caregiver Present for Every Two Children Under the Age of Two Years In (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
