At the Two-year Calendar Date in a Four Year Registration Cycle, a Program Must Be in Compliance with the Fol (2), and Suitable Precautions Must Be Taken to Eliminate All Conditions in Areas Accessible to Children Which Pose a Safety or Health Hazard. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
