Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Portable Electric Heaters or Other Portable Heating Devices, Regardless of the Type of Fuel Used, May Not Be Used in Rooms Accessible to the Children. (2) and All Paths of Egress on the Interior and Exterior of the Home, Including Corridors, Aisles and Approaches Must Be Kept Free of Obstructions, Impediments and Debr (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
