Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Trash, Garbage and Combustible Materials Must Not Be Stored in the Furnace Room or in Rooms or Outdoor Areas Adjacent to the Facility That Are Ordinarily Occupied (1), Each Applicant For, or Individual in the Position of Director, Teacher, or Volunteer Must Complete Office- Approved Training That Complies with Federal Minimum (1), and Mid-point Requirements for Four-year Registration Holders. At the Two-year Calendar Date in a Four Year Registration Cycle, a Program Must Be in Compliance With (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
