Such Equipment Must Be Properly Maintained for Use in the Event of a Powe (1), and Each Employee and Volunteer Must Complete a Minimum of Thirty (30) Hours of Training Every Two Years. The Required (30) Hours of Training Every Two Years Is Sub (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
