Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Protective Caps, Covers or Permanently Installed Obstructive Devices Must Be Used on All Electrical Outlets That Are Accessible to Children. (2), Peeling or Damaged Paint or Plaster Must Be Repaired. (1), and Cribs, Bassinets and Other Sleeping Areas for Infants Through 12 Months of Age Must Include an Appropriately Sized Fitted Sheet, and Must Not Have Bumper Pads, (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
