At the Two-year Calendar Date in a Four Year Licensing Cycle, a Program Must Be in Compliance with the Fol (2), and Windows Above the First Floor, Other Than Those Identified for Emergency Evacuation, That Are Accessible to Children and Which Present a Fall Hazard Must Be Pro (1).
