Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were All Corridors, Aisles, and Approaches to Exits Must Be Kept Unobstructed at All Times. (1), The Initial Medical Statement for Staff and Volunteers Must Include the Results of a Mantoux Tuberculin Test or Other Federally Approved Tuberculin Test Perform (1), and CPR and First Aid Certifications Must Be Appropriate to the Ages of the Children in Care. All Certifications in CPR and First Aid Must Contain an In-person Comp (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
