Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Porches, Decks or Stairs with More Than Two Steps Must Have Railings with a Barrier Extending to the Floor or Ground to Prevent Children From Falling. Acceptabl (2), Care Can Only Be Provided on Floors with Two Means of Egress. When Care Is Provided on the First Floor, and the Second Floor Is Without a Second Means of Egress (2), and When Care Is Provided for Children Under the Age of Two Years, There Must Be at Least One Caregiver Present for Every Two Children Under the Age of Two Years In (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
