Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Prescription Medications, Oral Over-the-counter Medications, Medicated Patches, and Eye, Ear, or Nasal Drops or Sprays, Can Be Administered by the Program for O (2) and All Child Care Programs Must Have at Least One Staff Person Who Holds a Valid Certification in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and First Aid on the Premises (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
