The Required (30) Hours of Training Every Two Years Is Sub (1), and Mid-point Requirements for Four-year Registration. At the Two-year Calendar Date in a Four Year Registration Cycle, a Program Must Be in Compliance with the FoI (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
