Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Evacuation Drills Must Be Conducted at Least Monthly During the Hours of Operation of the Family Day Care Home. (2), All Child Care Programs Must Have at Least One Caregiver, Who Holds a Valid Certification in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and First Aid, on the Premises (1), and Cribs, Bassinets and Other Sleeping Areas for Infants Through 12 Months of Age Must Include an Appropriately Sized Fitted Sheet, and Must Not Have Bumper Pads, (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
