Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Children Cannot Be Left Without Competent Supervision at Any Time. Competent Supervision Includes Awareness of and Responsibility for the Ongoing Activity of Ea (3), All Paths of Egress on the Interior and Exterior of the Home, Including Corridors, Aisles and Approaches Must Be Kept Free of Obstructions, Impediments and Debr (1), and A Written Individual Health Care Plan Must Be Developed for the Child; (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
