In the Case (1), Sleeping Surfaces, Including Bedding, Which Is the Removable and Washable Portion of the Sleeping Environment, Must Not Come in Contact with the Sleeping Surfac (1), and Children Cannot Be Left Without Competent Supervision at Any Time. Competent Supervision Includes Awareness of and Responsibility for the Ongoing Activity of Ea (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
