Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Cribs, Bassinets and Other Sleeping Areas for Infants Through 12 Months of Age Must Include an Appropriately Sized Fitted Sheet, and Must Not Have Bumper Pads, (2), One Caregiver May Care for a Maximum of Six Children Younger Than School Age, or Eight Children When at Least Two of the Eight Children Are School Aged. (2), and All Matches, Lighters, Medicines, Drugs, Detergents, Aerosol Cans and Other Poisonous or Toxic Materials Must Be Stored in Their Original Containers, and Must B (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
