(1), With the Exception of Children Meeting the Criteria of Section 417.11(a)(6) Children Enrolled in Child Day Care Must Remain Current with Their Immunizations In (1), and Protective Caps, Covers or Permanently Installed Obstructive Devices Must Be Used on All Electrical Outlets That Are Accessible to Children. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
