Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Methods of Discipline, Interaction or Toilet Training Which Frighten, Demean or Humiliate a Child Are Prohibited. (1), Sufficient and Suitable Clothing Must Be Available So That Children Who Dirty or Soil Their Clothing May Be Changed. All Such Clothing Must Be Returned to Paren (1), and Each Employee and Volunteer Must Complete a Minimum of Thirty (30) Hours of Training Every Two Years. The Required (30) Hours of Training Every Two Years Is Sub (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
