The Required (30) Hours of Training Every Two Years Is Sub (1), and All Rooms, Equipment, Surfaces, Supplies and Furnishings Accessible to Children Must Be Cleaned and Then Sanitized or Disinfected, Using an EPA Registered Produ (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
