(2), The Provider, Assistant(s), and Substitute(s), Must Each Submit a Medical Statement on Forms Furnished by the Office or an Approved Equivalent From a Health Car (2), and In Addition to a Smoke Detector on Each Floor, There Must Be a Smoke Detector Located Either Within Rooms Where Children Nap, or in Adjoining Rooms. In the Case (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
