Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were All Matches, Lighters, Medicines, Drugs, Detergents, Aerosol Cans and Other Poisonous or Toxic Materials Must Be Stored in Their Original Containers, and Must B (1), Television and Other Electronic Visual Media Must Be Turned Off While Children Are Sleeping, and During Established Nap Times. This Is Not to Prohibit a Program (1), and All Child Care Programs Must Have at Least One Caregiver, Who Holds a Valid Certification in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and First Aid, on the Premises (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
