(2), All Rooms, Equipment, Surfaces, Supplies and Furnishings Accessible to Children Must Be Cleaned and Then Sanitized or Disinfected, Using an EPA Registered Produ (1), and Cribs, Bassinets and Other Sleeping Areas for Infants Through 12 Months of Age Must Include an Appropriately Sized Fitted Sheet, and Must Not Have Bumper Pads, (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
