Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were All Paths of Egress on the Interior and Exterior of the Home, Including Corridors, Aisles and Approaches Must Be Kept Free of Obstructions, Impediments and Debr (2), A Temperature of at Least 68 Degrees Fahrenheit Must Be Maintained in All Rooms to Be Occupied by Children. (2), and Radiators and Pipes Located in Rooms Occupied by Children Must Be Covered to Protect the Children From Injury When the Heating System Is in Use. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
