Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Television and Other Electronic Visual Media Must Be Turned Off When Not Part of a Planned Developmentally Appropriate Program Activity. (1), Glass in Outside Windows Less Than 32 Inches Above the Floor Level Must Be of Safety Grade or Otherwise Protected by Use of Barriers to Avoid Accidental Impact. (1), and Evacuation Drills Must Be Conducted at Least Monthly During the Hours of Operation of the Family Day Care Home. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
