Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Barriers Must Exist to Prevent Children From Gaining Access to Any Swimming Pool, Drainage Ditches, Wells, Ponds or Other Bodies of Open Water Located on or Adj (3), When the Provider Is Absent for 3 or Fewer Consecutive Days, the Office Does Not Need to Be Notified in Advance; However the Program Must Keep a Written Record (1), and All Paths of Egress on the Interior and Exterior of the Home, Including Corridors, Aisles and Approaches Must Be Kept Free of Obstructions, Impediments and Debr (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
