(1), All Child Care Programs Must Have at Least One Staff Person Who Holds a Valid Certification in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and First Aid on the Premises (1), and Each Program Must Hold Two Shelter-in-place Drills Annually During Which Procedures and Supplies Are Reviewed. Parents Must Be Made Aware of This Drill in Advan (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
