(2), All Paths of Egress on the Interior and Exterior of the Home, Including Corridors, Aisles and Approaches Must Be Kept Free of Obstructions, Impediments and Debr (1), and The Required 30 Hours of Training Every Two Years Is Subject to the Following Conditions: Fifteen of the Required Thirty (30) Hours of Training Must Be Obtained (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
