All Applicants Whose Backgrounds Mu (2), Each Applicant For, or Individual in the Position of Director, Teacher, or Volunteer Must Complete Office- Approved Training That Complies with Federal Minimum (2), and Barriers Must Exist to Prevent Children From Gaining Access to Unsafe Areas. Such Areas Include, but Are Not Limited To, Swimming Pools, Drainage Ditches, Wells (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
