Applicants for Renewal of a Registration Must Submit to the Office at Least 60 Days in Advance of the Expiration Date of the Registration the Followin (2), Convenient, Adequate and Sanitary Toilet Facilities Must Be Provided for the Children in a Separate, Properly Ventilated Room Readily Accessible to Children. (1), and Suitable Precautions Must Be Taken to Eliminate All Conditions in Areas Accessible to Children Which Pose a Safety or Health Hazard. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
