Competent Supervision Includes Awareness of and Responsibility for the Ongoing Activity of Ea (2), The Licensee Must Obtain Written Consent on Forms Furnished by the Office or Approved Equivalents From the Parent of the Child for Any Transportation of the Chi (1), and Rooms That Will Be Used by the Children Must Be Well-lighted and Well-ventilated. Heating, Ventilating and Lighting Equipment Must Be Adequate for the Protectio (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
