(2), Peeling or Damaged Paint or Plaster Must Be Repaired. (1), and Children Must Be Kept Clean and Comfortable at All Times. Diapers Must Be Changed When Wet or Soiled. The Diaper Changing Area Must Be as Close as Possible to A (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
