Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were During a complaint investigation conducted by the Office of Licensing & Accreditation, 19 children were present with one provider, exceeding the required ratio of 1 provider to 15 children. (1), Adequate supervision was not maintained when children left the classroom, as the provider was not able to see or hear The children and was not positioned close enough to intervene at all times. (1), and Providers were not observed washing hands prior to serving snack, and children did not wash their hands before Consuming snack. (1). None of the 6 findings were critical.

- Two providers working with children did not have cleared background check eligibility documentation on file.
67:42:17:13 - 67:42:17:13 All child care providers, program employees age fourteen and older, and family day care household members age eighteen and older, shall meet federal background check requirements.
- Providers reported that they have not completed the required 10 hours of annual training.
67:42:17:18 - 67:42:17:18 All providers must obtain annual training in the topic areas as identified in 45 C.F.R. § 98.41, in effect on September 30, 2016, or as identified by the department.
- Adequate supervision was not maintained when children left the classroom, as the provider was not able to see or hear The children and was not positioned close enough to intervene at all times.
67:42:17:20 - 67:42:17:20 A center provider supervising children must be in the same room with the children or on the playground with the children, and must be able to see or hear them.
- During a complaint investigation conducted by the Office of Licensing & Accreditation, 19 children were present with one provider, exceeding the required ratio of 1 provider to 15 children.
67:42:17:21 - 67:42:17:21 A center or school-age program must maintain the following ratios: (1) Five children to one staff for children up to three years of age; (2) Ten children to one staff for children three years of age and older.
