Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Written Operational Policies - Promotion of Physical Activity (2), Infant May Not Sleep in a Restrictive Device - Remove the Infant From the Device and Place the Infant in a Crib as Soon as Possible (1), and Diaper Changing Equipment - Smooth, Non-absorbent, Easy to Clean Surface (1). Of 5 total findings, 2 were critical.
