Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Minimum Qualifications for Employees- Must Complete a Pre-Employment Affidavit for Applicants for Employment. (1), Other Prohibited Punishments-subjecting a Child to Abusive or Profane Language (1), and Children's rights-The Right to Be Free From Any Harsh, Cruel, Unusual, Unnecessary, Demeaning, or Humiliating Treatment or Punishment. (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
