Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Employee and Caregiver responsibilities-Competency, Prudent Judgment, Self-control in Presence of Children and When Performing Assigned Tasks (1), Other Prohibited Discipline-Any Harsh, Cruel, Unusual, Unnecessary, Demeaning, or Humiliating Discipline or Punishment (1), and Medication Record-Maintain Cumulative Record of Prescription Medications Dispensed to Child, Include Nonprescription Meds for Child Under Five Yrs Old (1). Of 4 total findings, 3 were critical.
