Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Caregiver Responsibility - Being Able to Intervene When Necessary to Ensure Child's Safety (2), Medication Record - Must Include Reason Medication Was Prescribed, for Prescription Medication (1), and Pre-Service Training- Caregivers Who Administer Medication Must Have Psych Medication Training Before Administering Psych Meds. (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
