Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Supervision-The Caregiver Is Responsible for Being Able to Intervene When Necessary to Ensure Each Child's Safety (1), Employee and Caregiver responsibilities-Competency, Prudent Judgment, Self-control in Presence of Children and When Performing Assigned Tasks (1), and Children's rights-Adhere to the Child's Rights to Be Free From Being Threatened with the Loss of Placement or Shelter as Punishment (1). Of 3 total findings, 2 were critical.
