(1), Employee General responsibilities-Demonstrate Competency, Prudent Judgment, Self-control in Presence of Children and When Performing Assigned Tasks (1), and Medication Storage-Store Medication Covered by Schedule II of the Texas Controlled Substances Act Under Double Lock in a Separate Container (1). Of 5 total findings, 2 were critical.
