Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Background Check Validation - Every 3 Months Each Operation, Other Than a Licensed, Registered, or Listed Home, Must Validate Current List (1), Child Must Be Immediately Treated by Health Prof, Contact Emergency Svs or Take Child to ER for Injury/illness Requiring Treatment by a Health Prof. (1), and Other Prohibited Discipline-Humiliating, Shaming, Ridiculing, Rejecting, or Yelling at a Child (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
