Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Physical Site- Buildings Must Be Clean and in Good Repair. (1), CPR Training- Must Adhere to AHA Guidelines & Include Curr. That Incudes Use of a CPR Manikin & Written & Hands-on Instruction/practice & Testing (1), and Serious Incident-Report to Licensing No Later Than 24 Hours After Becoming Aware That Child Is Indicted, Charged, or Arrested or When Police Respond. (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
