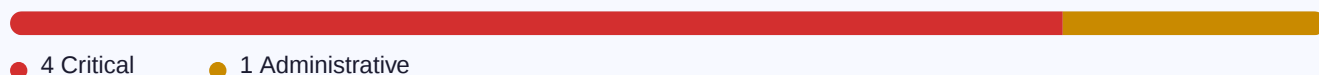

Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
